- Who are they? (demographics)
- What makes them tick? (psychographics)
- What do you want to focus on?





Who Are They?(Demographics)

- Gender, Age, Etc.
- Education, Job, Income, Etc.
- Where do they live?, Where do they play?, What do they like?





What Makes Them Tick? (Psychographics)

- What are their dreams and goals? Why is it important?
- What pain are they trying to get rid of?
- What do they believe?





What do you want to focus on?

- Who do you want to work with?
- What kind of business do you want to have?
- What specific type of reader do you want to be?

- Your own website

- What are their terms?
 - Who sets the prices? How do they pay you? Who handles payments?
 - What are the minimum tech requirements?
 - Are there aesthetic requirements?

Social Media

- Allows you to interact directly with people
- Which channel to use (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Tik Tok, etc.)
- How often to post (and what to post)

- Articles that show your expertise
- Informative, Listicles, How-To, Opinion-based
- Medium.com





Podcasts

- Set yourself up as an expert
- Show your personality
- Easily delivered and easy listen to
- Anchor.fm







Ebooks

- Establish yourself as an expert
- Opens up opportunities to leverage other people's tribes
- Doesn't have to take years to write
- Amazon KDP (ebook, paperback, hardcover)







Email

- Only resource you truly own
- Easy to develop relationships and deliver value
- No cost to promote products, services and specials
- Don't need a list of 1,000,000s







Don't Need A List Of 1,000,000s

- The Power of The True Fan
 - Will come back regularly for readings
 - Will travel to see you at events
 - Will buy three copies of your book (one to read, one to give away and one for you to sign and sit on their bookshelf)
- Only need 1000 True Fans
- \$100/year. (\$100 x 1000 True Fans = \$100,000!)







 - Get specific on which social media platform you're using...






